

What Does the Base Collect for Recycling?



Scrap Wood/Yard Waste
(crates, leaves, tree limbs)

Pallets



Scrap Metal
(wiring, drained crushed cans
and filters, scrap pieces and
parts, etc)



Toner and Printer Cartridges



Universal Waste (Batteries, used
oil, light bulbs, antifreeze)



Did you know McConnell landfills an average of over 4 tons of waste a day? The cost of tipping that waste is \$250 each day.
